

Detailed List of Injectable Weight Loss Medications:

Wegovy (semaglutide):

A once-weekly injection, approved for adults and adolescents 12 years and older who are obese or overweight with related health conditions.

Saxenda (liraglutide):

A daily injection, approved for adults and adolescents 12 years and older who are obese or overweight with related health conditions.

Zepbound (tirzepatide):

A once-weekly injection, approved for adults with obesity or overweight with related health conditions.

Imcivree (setmelanotide):

A daily injection, approved for people 6 years and older with obesity due to specific genetic conditions like POMC, PCSK1, LEPR deficiency, or BBS, according to the National Institutes of Health (NIH) | (.gov).

Mounjaro (tirzepatide):

While approved for diabetes, it is also sometimes prescribed off-label for weight loss due to its mechanism of action similar to Zepbound.

Ozempic (semaglutide):

Similar to Wegovy in its active ingredient, but primarily approved for diabetes. It is also sometimes prescribed off-label for weight loss, according to Drugs.com.

Victoza (liraglutide):

Another medication containing liraglutide, primarily approved for diabetes, but also sometimes prescribed off-label for weight loss, according to Drugs.com.
